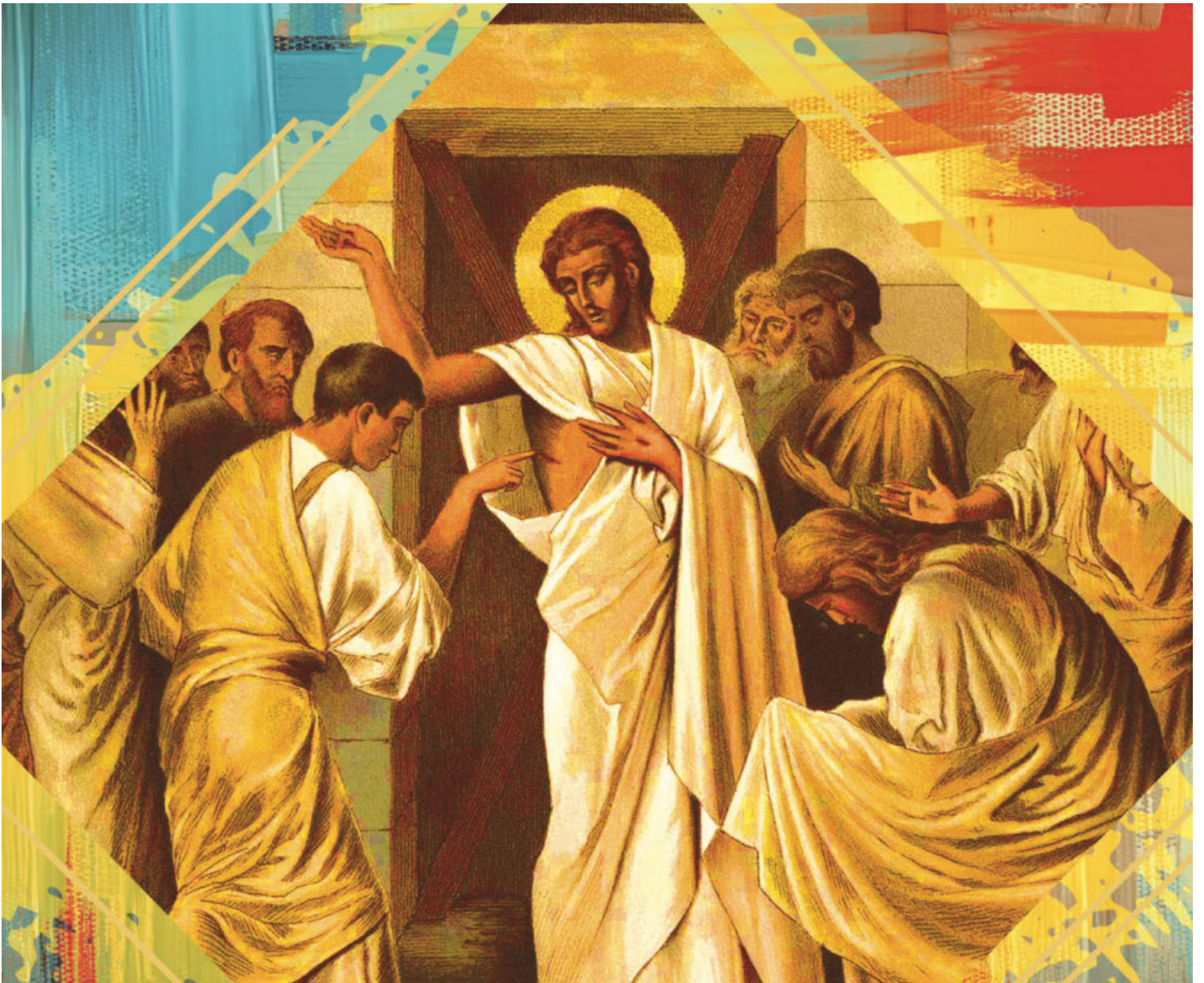

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Today, as we celebrate sacred occasion of Divine Mercy Sunday, we are reminded of the boundless and unfathomable mercy of our loving God. It is a day when we reflect on the profound depth of God's love for each one of us, a love so great that it surpasses all understanding.

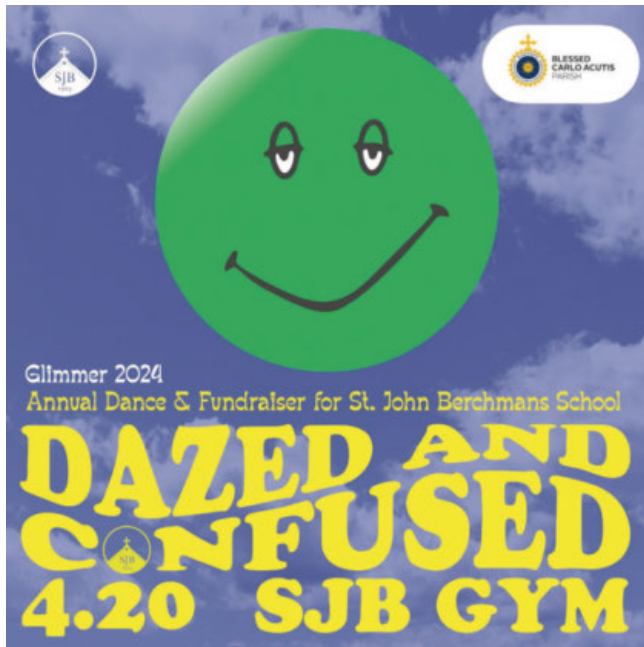

Estimados Hermanos y Hermanas,

Hoy, mientras celebramos la sagrada ocasión del Domingo de la Divina Misericordia, recordamos la misericordia ilimitada e insondable de nuestro amoroso Dios. Drodzy Bracia i Siostry,

Dziś, gdy świętujemy Niedzielę Miłosierdzia Bożego, przypominamy sobie o bezgranicznym i niezgłębionym miłosierdziu naszego kochającego Boga. Jest to dzień, w którym zastanawiamy się nad głęboką miłością Boga do każdego z nas, miłością tak wielką, że przewyższa wszelkie zrozumienie.

W czytaniach Ewangelii spotykamy się z potężnym obrazem Jezusa ukazującego się swoim uczniom po zmartwychwstaniu. Tchnie na nich Ducha Świętego, dając im władzę odpuszczania grzechów. Ten akt miłosierdzia ukazuje przemieniającą moc Bożej miłości i dar pojednania, który jest oferowany każdemu z nas.

Niedziela Miłosierdzia Bożego to nie tylko czas, w którym możemy przyjąć Boże miłosierdzie, ale także rozszerzyć je na innych. Wzywa nas do porzucenia urazy, przebaczenia tym, którzy nas skrzywdzili i szukania pojednania z naszymi braćmi i siostrami. Tak jak Boże miłosierdzie nie zna granic, tak i nasza zdolność do okazywania miłosierdzia innym musi być nieograniczona.

Św. Faustyna, wielka apostołka Bożego Miłosierdzia, przypomina nam, jak ważne jest całkowite zaufanie Bożemu miłosierdziu. Uczy nas zbliżać się do Boga z dziecięcą ufnością, wiedząc, że Jego miłosierdzie jest większe niż nasze grzechy i niepowodzenia. Poprzez swoje pisma i nabożeństwo do Miłosierdzia Bożego, św. Faustyna zaprasza nas do zanurzenia się w oceanie Bożego miłosierdzia i czerpania z niego siły i uzdrowienia.

Obchodząc Niedzielę Miłosierdzia Bożego, otwórzmy nasze serca na przyjęcie miłosierdzia, które Bóg tak hojnie nam ofiarowuje. Podejdźmy do Sakramentu Pojednania ze skruszonymi sercami, szukając przebaczenia za nasze grzechy i łaski do życia w świętości i cnocie.

Na zakończenie przypomnijmy sobie słowa Jezusa skierowane do św. Faustyny: "Im większy grzesznik, tym większe ma prawo do Mojego miłosierdzia". Bez względu na to, jak daleko zboczyliśmy z Bożej drogi, Jego miłosierdzie jest dla nas zawsze dostępne, jeśli tylko zwrócimy się do Niego z pokorą i ufnością. Niech obchody Niedzieli Miłosierdzia Bożego napełnią nasze serca radością i wdzięcznością za niezmierny dar Bożego miłosierdzia. Amen.
