FATHER MARSHALL

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Today's Gospel is frequently read at funerals and for good reason.

It contains promises that are profoundly comforting in the face of the death of a loved one. It is also comforting to us as it has everything to do with our lives here and now.

The setting is Jesus' farewell address at the last supper with his disciples. Jesus has washed the disciples' feet; he foretold them about his betrayal by Judas; he told them that he would be with them only a little while longer and that where he is going, they cannot come. He also told them of Peter's eminent denial.

No wonder the disciples are troubled!

Jesus responds to the anxiety of his disciples by saying: "Do not let your hearts be troubled, believe in God and believe also in me." Jesus calls them back to this fundamental relationship of trust and assures them that he is not abandoning them.

This Gospel speaks very well to each of our lives. Often our lives are shaken by unexpected events or changes. At those moments we can become unglued.

We look to the Risen Lord for guidance and especially peace. We need to hear the words over and over again – 'do not let your hearts be troubled...have faith in God and faith in me. In my Father's house there are many dwelling places otherwise how could I have told you I was going to prepare a place for you.'

Then Thomas, like us, asks the question "how can we know where you are going? We don't know the way." Jesus responds that He is the way, the truth, and the life.

It sounds so simple and direct. It comes down to trust. Do we trust Jesus enough to calm our hearts?

PADRE MARSHALL

Estimados Hermanos y Hermanas,

El Evangelio de hoy se lee con frecuencia en los funerales y por una buena razón.

Contiene promesas que son profundamente reconfortantes ante la muerte de un ser querido. También es reconfortante para nosotros, ya que tiene mucho que ver con nuestras vidas aquí y ahora.

El escenario es el discurso de despedida de Jesús en la última cena con sus discípulos. Jesús le lavo los pies de los discípulos; les predijo acerca de su traición por parte de Judas; les dijo que sólo estaría con ellos un poco más de tiempo y que adonde él iba, ellos no podrían ir. También les habló de la eminente negativa de Pedro.

¡Con razón los discípulos están preocupados!

Jesús responde a sus ansiosos discípulos diciendo: “Que no se perturbe sus corazones, crean en Dios y crean también en mí”. Jesús los anima a que se relacionen fundamentalmente con confianza y les asegura que no los abandona.

Este Evangelio habla muy bien de cada una de nuestras vidas. A menudo, nuestras vidas se ven sacudidas por eventos o cambios inesperados. En esos momentos podemos alejarnos.

Recurrimos al Señor Resucitado en busca de guía y especialmente de paz. Necesitamos escuchar las palabras una y otra vez: 'Que no se perturbe vuestro corazón... tened fe en Dios y fe en mí. En la casa de mi Padre hay muchas moradas, de lo contrario, ¿cómo podría haberles dicho que les iba a preparar un lugar?

Entonces Tomas, como nosotros, hace la pregunta “¿cómo podemos saber a dónde vas? No conocemos el camino. Jesús responde que Él es el camino, la verdad y la vida.

Suena tan simple y directo. Todo se reduce a la confianza. ¿Confiamos lo suficiente en Jesús para calmar nuestros corazones?

Drodzy Bracia i Siostry,

Dzisiejsza Ewangelia jest często czytana na pogrzebach i to nie bez powodu.

Ona zawiera obietnice, które pocieszają nas w obliczu śmierci bliskiej osoby. Ona jest to również pocieszająca dla nas, ponieważ zawiera wszystko co jest wspólne z naszym życiem teraz.

Miejszem ewangelii jest przemowa pożegnalna Jezusa podczas ostatniej wieczerzy z uczniami. Jezus umył uczniom nogi; przepowiedział im zdradę ze strony Judasza; powiedział że będzie z nimi tylko trochę dłużej i że tam, gdzie on idzie, oni nie mogą przyjść. Powiedział im także o wybitnym zaparciu się Piotra.

To nic dziwnego, że uczniowie są zmartwieni!

Jezus odpowiada na ich niepokój słowami: „Niech się nie trwoży serce wasze, wiercie w Boga i wiercie też we mnie”. Jezus wzywa ich z powrotem do tej podstawowej zasady zaufania i zapewnia, że ich nie opuszcza na zawsze.

Ta Ewangelia świetnie przemawia do każdego z nas. Często naszym życiem wstrząsają nieoczekiwane wydarzenia lub zmiany. W takich momentach możemy się wzruszyć.

Oczekujemy od Zmartwychwstałego Pana przewodnictwa, a zwłaszcza pokoju. Potrzebujemy ciągle na nowo słyszeć słowa – „niech się nie trwoży serce wasze... miejcie wiarę w Boga i wiarę we mnie”. W domu mojego Ojca jest wiele mieszkań, bo inaczej jak mógłbym wam powiedzieć, że przygotowuję wam miejsce”.

Następnie Tomasz, podobnie jak my, zadaje pytanie: „skąd możemy wiedzieć, gdzie idziesz? Nie znamy drogi. Jezus odpowiada, że on jest drogą, prawdą i życiem.

Brzmi to tak prosto i bezpośrednio. To prowadzi do zaufania. Czy ufamy Jezusowi na tyle, by uspokoić nasze serca?
