El tercer capítulo del evangelio de Juan que escuchamos hoy proclama que el Padre ama al mundo y que envió a Su Hijo para que compartiera la vida eterna con todos los que creen. El Dios que contemplamos hoy está presente en, con y para nosotros. La historia del amor de Dios, Jesús, el Verbo Encarnado, nos introduce en su relación con Dios como el Padre.

Drodzy Bracia i Siostry,

Następna niedziela po Zesłaniu Ducha Świętego jest Niedzielą Trójcy Świętej. Ona daje nam czas na zastanowienie się nad Trójcą Świętą i jej wpływem na nasze życie duchowe.

Trzeci rozdział Ewangelii Jana, którego dzisiaj słuchamy, głosi, że Ojciec miłuje świat i posłał Swego Syna, aby dzielił życie wieczne ze wszystkimi wierzącymi. Bóg, którego dziś rozważamy, jest obecny w nas, z nami i dla nas. Historia miłości Boga, Jezusa i Słowa Wcielonego, wprowadza nas w Jego relację z Bogiem jako Ojcem.

Trójca Święta oferuje nam cenny dar relacji, solidnego połączenia z Bogiem, sobą, innymi i światem

Jesteśmy zaproszeni, aby być jak Trójca, żyjąc w absolutnej relacji.
