Dear Brothers and Sisters,

You and I are instruments of God in the world. That is our true vocation in life. In order to be a fine tuned instrument, we need to be in harmony with God, the divine Maestro. What is necessary for effective evangelization? If the true meaning of evangelization is sharing the Good News of Jesus and his presence in our lives, we need to continually develop our personal relationship with God. We cannot introduce God to someone if we do not know him ourselves. So, the first step in becoming an effective evangelizer is allowing God into our lives and letting God be the maestro, the master of our lives.

You may be thinking that evangelization is something done by deacons, priests, religious brothers and sisters, etc. All are called to evangelize. Remember, it is not something that we do, but it is what God does through the power of the Holy Spirit acting in us.

In order for this to happen we have to be open to that Holy Spirit and recognize the presence and power of the Holy Spirit impacting our lives. Some questions that you might want to consider are: "Do I have a significant relationship with God; how is that reflected in my daily life; and how do I continually allow God to build on that relationship in the midst of my family life, work place, trials, joys, worries and all of the other persons and things that occupy my time and thoughts?" Let's pray through some of those questions and allow ourselves to be tuned by the Maestro, God.

We also offer ongoing formation classes for the children who have received their Sacraments and are interested in continuing to learn more about their faith.

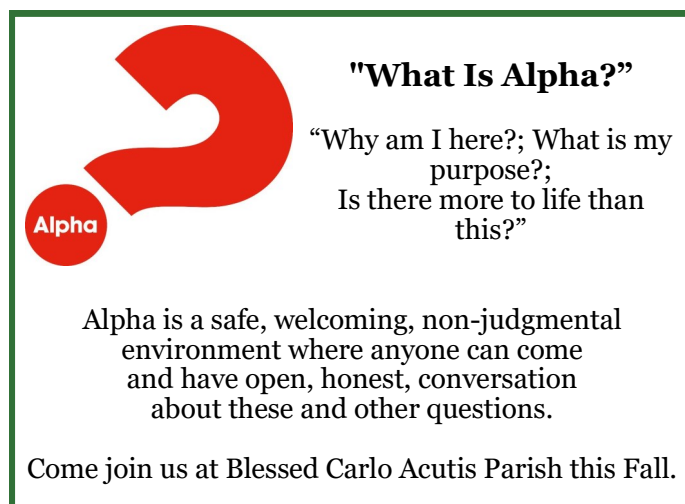

Estimados Hermanos y Hermanas,

Usted y yo somos instrumentos de Dios en el mundo. Esa es nuestra verdadera vocación en la vida. Para ser un instrumento afinado, necesitamos estar en armonía con Dios, el divino Maestro. ¿Qué es necesario para que una evangelización sea efectiva? Si el verdadero significado de la evangelización es compartir la Buena Nueva de Jesús y su presencia en nuestras vidas, necesitamos desarrollar continuamente nuestra relación personal con Dios. No podemos presentar a Dios a alguien si no lo conocemos nosotros mismos. Entonces, el primer paso para convertirse en un evangelizador efectivo es permitir que Dios entre en nuestras vidas y permitir que Dios sea el maestro, el maestro de nuestras vidas.

Usted puede estar pensando que la evangelización es algo que los diáconos, sacerdotes, hermanos y hermanas religiosos, etc. hacen. Todos estamos llamados a evangelizar. Recuerde, no es algo que hacemos, pero es lo que Dios hace a través del poder del Espíritu Santo que actúa en nosotros.

Algunas preguntas que tal vez desee considerar son: "¿Tengo una relación significativa con Dios? ¿Cómo se refleja eso en mi vida diaria? ¿Y cómo permito que Dios construya continuamente sobre esa relación en medio de mi vida familiar y laboral, en el trabajo, en las experiencias, alegrías, preocupaciones y todas las demás cosas y personas que ocupan mi tiempo y mis pensamientos? Oremos y reflejemos con algunas de esas preguntas y permitámonos ser sintonizados por el Maestro.

SIOSTRA DIANE MARIE COLLINS

Drodzy Bracia i Siostry,

My jesteśmy narzędziami Boga w naszym świecie. To jest nasze prawdziwe powołanie w życiu. Aby być dobrze nastrojonym instrumentem, musimy żyć w harmonii z Bogiem, boskim Maestro. Ale co jest potrzebne do skutecznej ewangelizacji? Jeśli prawdziwym sensem ewangelizacji jest dzielenie się Dobrą Nowiną o Jezusie i Jego obecności w naszym życiu, to musimy nieustannie rozwijać naszą osobistą relację z Bogiem. Nie możemy przedstawić Boga komuś, jeśli sami Go nie znamy. Tak więc pierwszym krokiem aby zostać skutecznym ewangelizatorem jest wpuszczenie Boga do naszego życia i pozwolenie Bogu, aby był mistrzem, panem naszego życia.

Może myślisz, że ewangelizacją zajmują się tylko diakoni, księża, bracia i siostry zakonne itd. Wszyscy jesteśmy wezwani do ewangelizacji. Pamiętaj, że nie jest to coś, co robimy, ale to, co Bóg czyni poprzez moc działającego w nas Ducha Świętego.

Aby tak się stało, musimy być otwarci na tego Ducha Świętego i rozpoznać obecność i moc Ducha Świętego wpływającą na nasze życie. Sposób, w jaki żyjemy i wchodzimy w interakcje z innymi ludźmi, decyduje o skuteczności naszej ewangelizacji. Niektóre pytania, które możesz chcieć rozważyć, to: „Czy mam znaczącą więź z Bogiem; jak to odbija się na moim codziennym życiu i jak stale pozwalam Bogu budować na tej relacji pośród mojego życia rodzinnego, pracy miejsce, próby, radości, zmartwienia i wszystkie inne osoby i rzeczy, które zajmują mój czas i myśli?” Pomódlmy się nad niektórymi z tych pytań i pozwólmy się dostroić przez naszego Maestro, Boga.
